EL-061 Electrical Energy Storage

BACKGROUND

Standards Australia has allocated a seat to the IEEE on their new technical committee EL-061 "Electrical Energy Storage". Nominations are called from suitably qualified IEEE members who would be willing to undertake this role.

EL-061 ELECTRICAL ENERGY STORAGE

This technical committee has been newly formed by Standards Australia. As such, there are presently no terms of reference available and one of the tasks of the committee will be to determine its terms of reference. However, the following information is available:

- the scope is likely to be similar to that of the International Electrotechnical Commission technical committee IEC TC 120, see <http://www.iec.ch/tc120>
- at least initially, EL-061 will be concerned only with products and not with installation issues;
- one task is likely to be the possible adoption in Australia of IEC 62619;
- once published, DR AS/NZS 5139 (currently at public comment) will be transferred to EL-061 for ongoing maintenance.

WORKLOAD

The workload of serving on a Standards Australia technical committee varies greatly, depending on what work the committee is carrying out at the time. Committee members should be available to attend face-to-face meetings, generally at Standards Australia's premises in Sydney but sometimes in other states. The number of such meetings a year will depend on the workload of the committee at the time and thus may vary significantly but would typically average two or three meetings a year. Additionally, there may be teleconferences and some matters may be decided by email.

CRITERIA

Applicants must be IEEE members (including Graduate Student Members) in good standing and have demonstrated expertise and experience in the field(s) covered by the technical committee. Applications are not open to Students, Associates or Society Affiliates.
